Anti Malarials

Generic Malarone

Taken: Daily for two days before you go, each day you are there, and for one week after leaving the risk area

Mefloquine (Larium)

Taken: Weekly for one week before you go, each week you are there, and for four weeks after leaving the risk area

Cost: £15.00 for one week away (6 tablets) +£3.50 for each additional week (+1 tablet)

Doxycycline

Taken: Daily (one tablet/day) for the week before you go, each day you are there, and four weeks after leaving the risk area

Cost: £15.00 for one week away (42 tablets) +£3.00 for each additional week (+7 tablets)

Chloroquine (taken weekly) & Paludrine (taken daily) TRAVEL PACK

Taken: } for one week before you go, each day you are there, and for four weeks after leaving the risk zone
